European Competition

Call for a musical composition inspiring the values of education and sport.

The University of Urbino "Carlo Bo"- **Faculty of Health and Physical Education**, in relation to the transnational project "EDUCATION AND SPORT: VALUES WITHOUT LIMITS", approved by the European Commission within the framework of the European Year of Education through Sport 2004 (EYES), announces the following Competition to create a musical composition inspiring the values of sport.

Rules

Art. 1

The objective is to compose a musical piece having the qualities of a HYMN, appropriate to represent the coming-together of different European cultures on the occasion of sport events.

Art. 2

The competition is open, without age restrictions, to individual citizens of the European Union, resident in Italy or in other member states of the European Union.

Each competitor may also submit more than one Composition.

Art. 3

The musical compositions presented must be original, without limitations in expression or form provided that they pertain to the object of the Competition (HYMN characteristics).

It must not exceed the duration of five minutes.

The Compositions must be written for the following constituent elements of the Symphonic Band:

Piccolo

2 Flutes

Oboe

Bassoon

Bb Clarinet (I-II-III)

BB Bass Clarinet

2 Alto Sax
Tenor Sax
Bariton Sax
2 F Horns
3 Bb Trumpets
3 Trombones
Euphonium
Tuba
String Bass
Timpani (two kettles)
Percussion Instruments (keyboards excluded) maximum 3 instrumentalists

The musical compositions must be submitted with complete scores and, where possible, also arranged for piano.

Art. 4

The Compositions must have a title and must be anonymous. The same title must also be written on the outside of a sealed envelope containing personal data and the application form. (Attachment A).

Musical scores, possible arrangements for piano and sealed envelopes must be sent in a sealed, anonymous envelope bearing the wording “European Year of Education through Sport 2004 transnational project “Education and Sport: Values without Limits”, Musical Composition Competition – to: Facoltà di Scienze Motorie dell’Università degli Studi di Urbino “Carlo Bo”, Via Muzio Oddi, n.14, 61029 Urbino (PU), Italia.

Musical scores, arrangements and envelopes must **reach** the address indicated above on or before 2:00 p.m. June 12th 2004, under penalty of exclusion from the competition.

Art.5

A special international Commission composed of five musicians of great renown nominated by the Dean of the Faculty of Health and Physical Education of the University of Urbino “Carlo Bo” and presided by the same without the right of vote, will evaluate the musical compositions submitted and will proclaim the winner.

The author of the piece proclaimed winner will receive a prize of **1.500,00** Euro gross.

The musical piece will be published under the care of the University of Urbino “Carlo Bo” according to the rules in force in Italy on the subject of copyright.

The authors of the first three pieces classified will be rewarded with a trip to Brussels where their works will be presented to the Community Institutions.

The Faculty of Health and Physical Education of the University of Urbino reserves the right to organise a public presentation in which the first three musical compositions classified and possibly others pointed out by the Commission, will be executed under the care of the Conservatory of Music “G. Rossini” of Pesaro.

The pertinency of the musical content to the object of the Competition will be among the criteria of judgement adopted by the Commission (HYMN characteristics).

Art.6

The organisational Secretariat of the Competition will communicate the outcome to the winner as well as the second and third classified by registered letter (the authors may receive information by directly contacting the organisational Secretariat of the Competition by phone +39 0722 351728).

Within 10 days of receiving the communication, the winners must send the parts for the execution to the Secretary.

Consigned material will not be returned by the office but can be reobtained by the participant at his/her own expense on or before September 30th 2004. The Faculty of Health and Physical Education reserves the right to conserve a copy of the works submitted.

Art.7

Grounds for exclusion from the competition are: not respecting terms for the consignment of work; incomplete information filed on the application form; not respecting the requisites regarding the realisation of the musical piece.

Jury members and their relatives or kindred to the third degree of descent are prohibited from participating in the Competition.

Art.8

The contestants pledge not to cede any rights to third parties relative to use and profit of the musical Composition until the winners are proclaimed.

Art.9

Participation in the Competition implies the total acceptance of the given Rules. The Tribunal of Urbino is competent to deal with any controversy.

REQUEST
