## THE RATIONALE OF THE EVENT

The international youth meeting “*Europe and beyond: Talks about frontiers*” finds its origin in the project “*Le Marche: A Region as a Laboratory*”, promoted by the Directorate General of the Regional Head Office for Le Marche Schools, with the aim of giving our schools the occasion on which to reflect upon the increasing complexity of their role and upon some current issues of particular pedagogical, educational and social prominence, to recover and reaffirm the value of a **mild-toned dialectic**, which is necessary to all those who focus their interests on the respect of the dignity of every human person and of its daily journey in the quest for “the right measure” between the individual wealth and the common one.

Along this path, school returns a high sense of its mission to the community, which comes true in the multi-faceted interaction and collaboration with other institutions in the territory and becomes “a laboratory” because it gives the opportunity to recover the handicraft dimension of the cultural capital that it enshrines.

The philosophy of the event is linking life experiences of persons coming from different countries and giving their thoughts and feelings of citizenship a chance to meet.

In the first edition of *Europe and beyond: Talks about frontiers*” the central topic was “*Searching for the traces of a common humanity*”, whereas in the second edition it was “*The heart and the mind. The humanity of humanity*” (Please, visit our website at [www.marche.istruzione.it](http://www.marche.istruzione.it)).

In this 2008’s edition (the third edition), which is taking place in the “*European year of intercultural dialogue*”, we would like to reflect upon “*The eye, the silence, the word*”.

In 2007/2008 school year, we are having 21021 schoolgirls and schoolboys in Le Marche Region, over 10% of the total school population.

## AIMS

The idea which moves “*Europe and beyond: Talks about frontiers*” is that of:

- To give young people from different latitudes a unique occasion on which to evenly feel guests of the world, to come together and think of an idea of citizenship which could be of great use to bridge frontiers of all kinds, not only geographical, to recognize in each one, in reciprocity, the traces of our belonging to one common humanity.
- To introduce young people to the role of the *Committee of the Regions* in Europe, and in particular in those regions of special interest for the *Commission for External Relations and Decentralised Cooperation*
- In particular, we are inviting to the international meeting teachers and students from those European and Non-European Countries which at present are running joint student exchange programmes in cooperation with Le Marche Region and are involved in Le Marche Day programme, namely Argentina, Canada, Australia, etc. The aim is that of fostering further and steadier relationships among generations of people sharing the same “marchegian” identity, being this indeed among the major reasons for the Region to celebrate Le Marche Day on the 10<sup>th</sup> of December each year.
